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## Applying to withdraw from your S6 Loan Provider account?

You need to give 14 days notice to withdraw. Sounds tough? It's meant to be! The Loan Provider is an interest bearing account designed to help you resist the temptation of dipping into your savings.

You can apply to withdraw from your Loan Provider if:

You don't have a current loan with First Credit Union where the S6 Loan Provider account is part of your loan agreement.

Your S6 Loan Provider account is not being used as security for an overdraft on your S1 account.
