DRIVER LICENSE

By law, we need to properly identify and collect information about you.

We collect this information in three steps: Identification (must be current), proof of address, other information



We can accept the following forms of identification. At least one form of ID needs to contain a photo. Choose from one of the following options.

Youth (12-14 years) or Teen (15-17 years)

We can accept the following forms of identification. Choose from one of the following options.

Option 1	Passport (NZ or overseas*)	Not required
Option 2	Student ID NZ Driver Licence (16 years+)	Birth Certificate (NZ** or overseas)
Option 3	Birth Certificate (NZ** or overseas)	Parent or Guardian's ID as listed under step 1 above

Jimmy Jumper (0-11 years old)

We can accept the following forms of identification.

	Primary Identification	Secondary Identification
Option 1	Birth Certificate (NZ** or overseas) Passport (NZ or overseas*)	Parent or Guardian's ID as listed under step 1 above

^{*}NZ Residency Visa must accompany overseas passports or work visa

Step 2: Proof of address

We require one form of address verification (not older than 3 months).

These can be:

Utility bill

Local council notification/

Rates bill

demand

Bank statement
 Educational institution letter

IRD Tax notice
 Rental tenancy agreement

Step 3: Other information

We may ask you for additional information if your identification documents are issued by a country other than New Zealand.

All documents must be originals. We can accept copies of documents that have been certified by a trusted referee such as a:

Lawyer Justice of the peace Chartered accountant Priest Registered teacher Registered medical doctor Police Constable Member of Parliament Deputy registrar, district/high court

This certification must contain the name, occupation and signature of the trusted referee and the date of the certification.
